MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

Another busy week in school has seen our Reception children access the dining hall for their dinners for the first time and the school photographer has captured your children's images for posterity. PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If your child was born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017 they will be due to start primary school in September 2021. You MUST complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by 15 January 2021.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 October 2020 until the closing date for applications on 15 January 2021.

Please note: Even if your child already attends a school nursery or has an older sibling at school please do not assume that your child will automatically gain a place at that school.

SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Reminder to Year 6 Parents

If your child is due to start secondary school in 2021 then you will have to apply for a school place before 31 October 2020. You MUST complete an application form either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing the application form provided by your home local authority.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 September 2020 until the closing date for applications on 31 October 2020.
