MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

After many false starts, the school finally converted to become an academy on 1st November. We have become a founding member of **Elements Diocesan Learning Trust** along with Pedmore C.E. Primary School. We expect Christ Church Primary and St. Mary's Primary to join the Multi Academy Trust at some stage in the near future. I anticipate that there will be several other Church of England primary schools in Dudley who will join Elements in the coming years as schools try to meet the Government requirement for all schools to become academies by 2030. Initially, I do not anticipate that, as parents, you will notice many- if any - differences to how the school operates. The main change is that we are now accountable to the Elements Board rather than to **Dudley Local Authority. I firmly** believe that this step will enable us to retain all that is good about our school, whilst gaining an additional layer of challenge and support in order to ensure that we continue to meet our children's needs.

Our Reception children finally got a break in the weather and managed to visit the local park as park of their work on autumn. A lovely time was had and the children enjoyed the adventure of getting out of school for a while! This afternoon, we also welcomed a wide range of prospective parents for our Reception intake in 2023.
