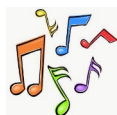
MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

MUSIC LESSONS

We will again be working with Dudley Performing Arts (DPA) to provide instrumental tuition at our school from September.

It will be possible to learn the following instruments:
Brass (e.g. trumpet, trombone)
Woodwind (e.g. clarinet, flute)
Strings (e.g. violins)
Keyboard
Guitars (acoustic & electric)
Vocal Coaching (singing for all ages)

Pupils will receive 34 lessons during the year, which take place during school hours.

Tuition costs £6.30 per lesson (£71.40 per term) and fees are paid on a termly basis.

Instruments except keyboard and guitar are available to hire at a cost of £10 per term.

If your child would like to receive instrument tuition from September, letters are available from the school office.

If your child currently receives music lessons and would like to continue in September, please return the letter sent home as soon as possible.

For further information about music lessons, please speak to Mrs Nichols in the first instance, or Mrs Reynolds in the school office.
