## PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 they will be due to start primary school in September 2020. You MUST complete an application either online at [www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions) or by completing an application form from your home local authority by **15 January 2020**.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 October 2019 until the closing date for applications on 15 January 2020.

Please note: Even if your child already attends a school nursery or has an older sibling at school please do not assume that your child will automatically gain a place at that school.
