PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If your child was born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015 they will be due to start primary school in September 2019. You **MUST** complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by **15 January 2019**.

The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 October 2018 until the closing date for applications on 15 January 2019.

Please note: Even if your child already attends a school nursery or has an older sibling at school please do not assume that your child will automatically gain a place at that school.

Children in Reception and Key Stage 1 may come to school in their party clothes and children in Key Stage 2 should bring their party clothes with them in a named bag and change after lunch.
