SCHOOL DINNERS

The menus have all been uploaded onto the school money system now so when you order a school meal for your child you are able to choose from the menu what they would like to eat each day. Can we remind parents that school meals need to be booked and paid for in advance—you are unable to book a meal on the day online. If you are still having difficulties accessing the school money system, please let us know.

PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 they will be due to start primary school in September 2020. You MUST complete an application either online at www.dudley.gov.uk/admissions or by completing an application form from your home local authority by 15 January 2020. The online system will be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from 1 October 2019 until the closing date for applications on 15 January 2020.

Please note: Even if your child already attends a school nursery or has an older sibling at school please do not assume that your child will automatically gain a place at that school.

ENTERING SCHOOL
