As a result, we have a brand new state of the art video projector, a huge upgrade on what was there before. Whilst the scaffolding tower was up, they also installed a rainbow lighting system to be used at school discos and removed the archaic stage lighting. A new LED stage lighting system will shortly be erected, in time for our Y6 pupils to perform their end of year play on the stage.
