



## Coronavirus Visitor Protocol

We are monitoring the development of the coronavirus outbreak and associated risks.

We follow the guidance from the Government and Public Health England (PHE), as well as any additional guidance from Dudley Local Authority.

We take the health and wellbeing of our pupils extremely seriously and we take all reasonable precautions to protect our pupils and staff.

We therefore require all visitors:

- Not to have visited any affected Category 1 area (according to the list on Gov.UK) within the past 14 days.
- To the best of their knowledge, not to have had contact with anyone who has been in one of these affected areas in the past 14 days.
- To declare if they have shown any of the coronavirus symptoms, in which case they will not be admitted to the school until given the all clear.
- any prospective visitor who has visited a Category 2 area (according to the list on Gov.UK) and has shown symptoms of the coronavirus to declare this to the school and, in the event, should not enter the school premises.

This is a situation that is changing on a daily basis. We will continue to monitor and issue new information and guidance as appropriate.

Visitors to school must have a prior appointment with a named member of staff.

Visitors should wear a face covering.

Visitors will work only in areas designated to them and with the children assigned to them.

The school's Covid-19 risk assessment – as published on the website – will be adhered to at all times.
