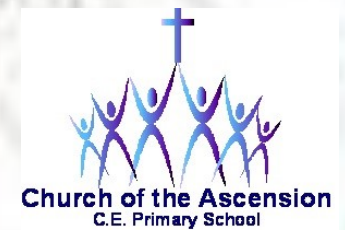


MFL at Church of the Ascension Primary School

At Church of the Ascension, we believe that learning a foreign language is a necessary part of being a member of an increasingly multi-cultural and multi-lingual society.

Children have the opportunity to develop an interest in languages which is taught in an enjoyable and stimulating way. Children begin learning in KS2 where they use and apply a growing French vocabulary. They have an opportunity to confidently express their ideas and develop their communication skills through speaking, listening, reading and writing, with the opportunity to do so for practical purposes. This provides an appreciation of cultures beyond their own and gives children a new and broader perspective of the world.

Examples of Learning

Throughout their time at Church of the Ascension, children progressively acquire skills and knowledge beginning in KS2 about greetings, the alphabet, numbers, colours, animals, food, body (appearance), hobbies and school life. The children have an opportunity to be taught by a specialist French teacher in UKS2 and learn through a range of learning styles, including songs, word games and interactive activities.
